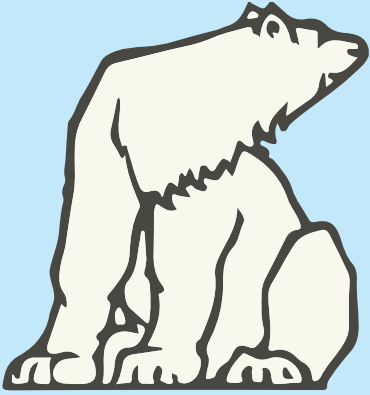


In comatose survivors of cardiac arrest,

ICECAP

a clinical trial to find the best duration of cooling after out-of-hospital cardiac arrest, and whether cooling improves outcomes.

ICECAP enrolls adults that are unresponsive and intubated after resuscitation from out of hospital cardiac arrest, who are cooled to <34 deg C within 240 minutes of 911 call, and have a definitive temperature control device applied. The study team will ask a legally authorized representative about informed consent and intent to maintain life support for 5 days before prognostication.
