#### **NEW MEETING ALERT!**



#### **Educational Video for Clinical and Study Teams**


With new residents on-boarding at your sites soon, we thought it was time to to recirculate the educational video. Please share with new clinical staff!

## Scientific Rationale for the Potential Efficacy of HBO2 in Severe TBI

One of the surmountable barriers to enrolling patients in this trial is the refusal of informed consent by LARs. We believe that in some cases informed consent may be obtainable if the consenting clinician/coordinator is armed with the right information regarding the scientific rationale for the study and the strength of the prior work supporting this study. As a result, we have drafted a one page summary of the scientific rational and evidence supporting this study. Please share this broadly with anyone involved in the consenting process.




