UPCOMING SIREN TRIALSAND TRIALS IN DEVELOPMENT

- ElectroBOOST (EEG biomarker BOOST-3 substudy)
 - Setup in process
- POST-ICECAP (ICECAP substudy)
 - Longitudinal study of post ROSC patients up to 12 months post arrest; funded, preparing to enroll (open to ICECAP screen failures)
- P-ICECAP Extended (P-ICECAP substudy)
 - Longitudinal follow up substudy; approved by Council, waiting for the NOA
- P-ICECAP EEG (P-ICECAP substudy)
 - Proposal submitted.
- P-ICECAP Extended (P-ICECAP substudy)
 - Longitudinal follow up substudy; approved by Council, waiting for the NOA
- P-ICECAP Microbiome (P-ICECAP substudy)
 - Effect of cooling on gut microbiome; preparing to submit
- **SPEED** (Seizure Prevalence by Electroencephalography in the Emergency Department)
 - Bedside EEG for subclinical status epilepticus resubmitted, did not get a fundable score; will go back to reconceptualization
- CABO (<u>Cardiac Arrest Biomarkers & Outcomes</u>)
 - Scored, not fundable; may be resubmitted
- **VETO-Sepsis** (Etomidate vs. Ketamine)
 - Proposed as a pilot study; will be submitted as a full trial
- **ED-SED** (Emergency Department SEDation)
 - Less sedation after intubation submitted once; did not get a fundable score; may be resubmitted in January/February
- **WINDSURFER** (Respiratory failure humidified high flow oxygen therapy [HHfO] vs. bi-level positive airway pressure [BiPap])
 - Submitted in October
- **PS-ECMO** (Practice Patterns in ED ECPR)
 - Surveys are completed; next step is the project conceptualization

 - Dose finding study; resubmitted in November
- KESETT (Ketamine in Established Status Epilepticus Treatment Trial)
 - Resubmitted in November
