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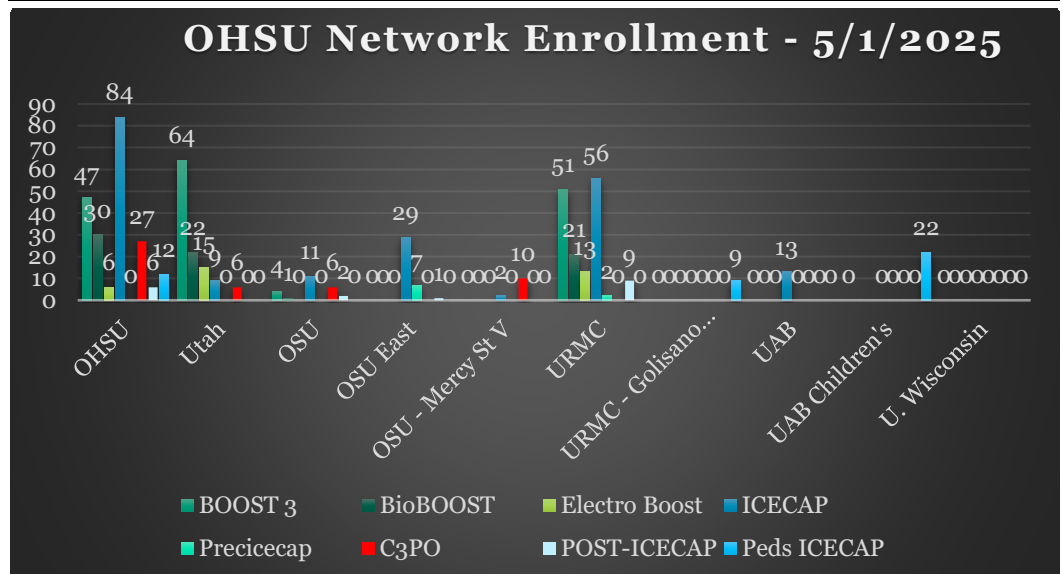

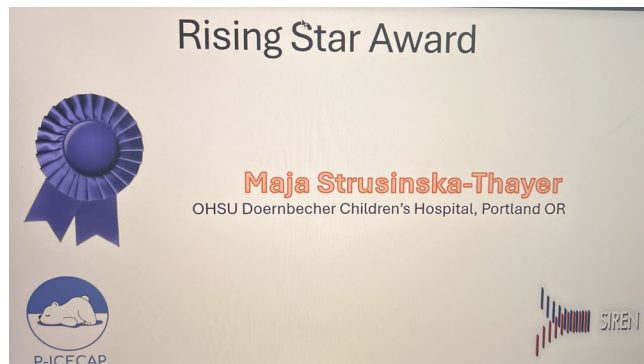

- Why don't I have a KESETT tile in WebDCU? You're not alone! The CRF database is still in development. At this point there has not been a date sent for when this will be available, but usually this will be closer to the start of study.
- What can I be doing?
 - Review the protocol and MOP and start thinking about how the workflow for enrollment may work at your site.
 - Check with your IT about your Wi-Fi access in the ED, and any security review you may need to do for the Ceribell device.
 - Contact your research pharmacy team to check on the process and what documents you need to send to set up the study drug at your site.
 - Identify some groups in your area who would be good to talk to for the community consultation process!
 - For example, your local farmers market events, county fairs, and epilepsy foundation may be good connections to make
