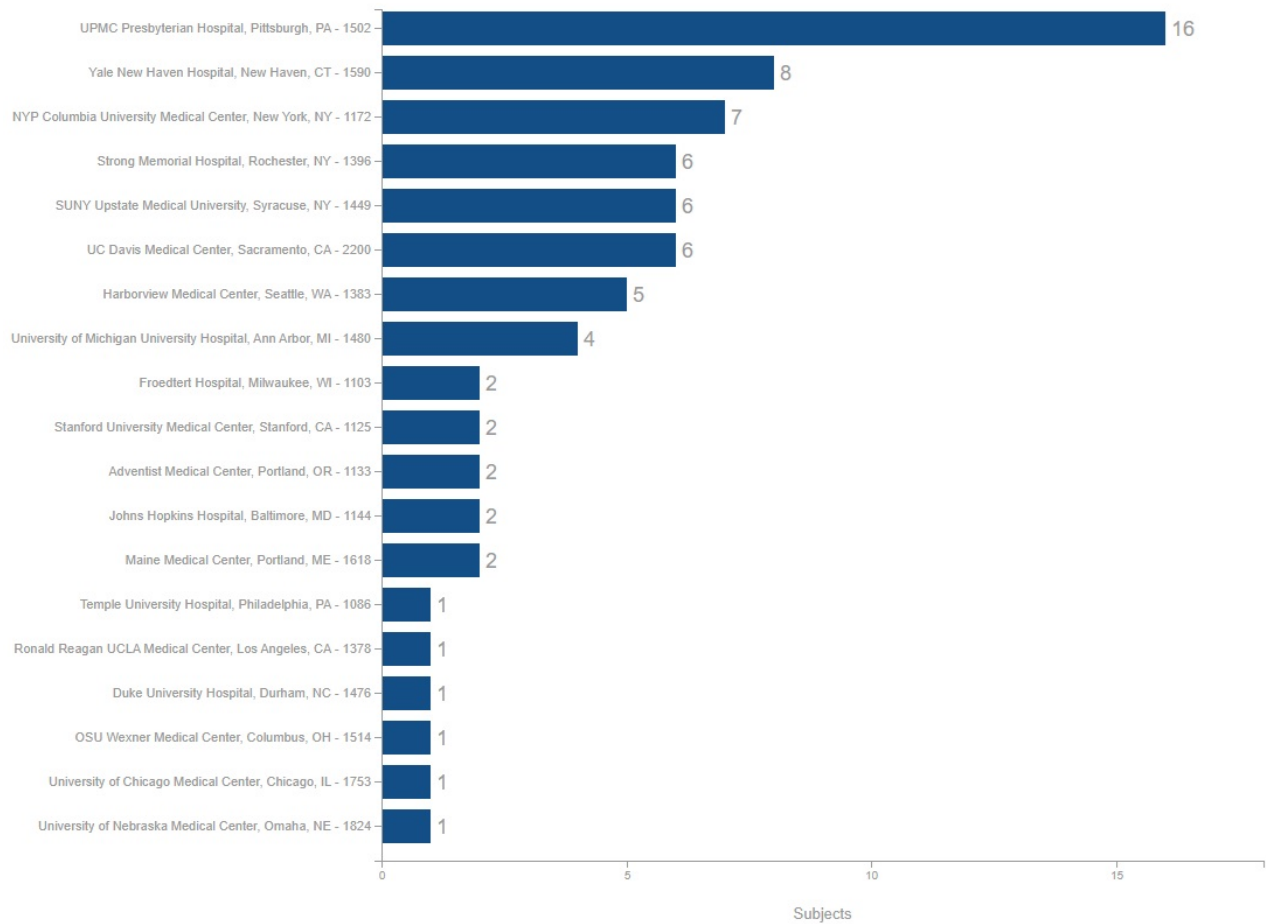

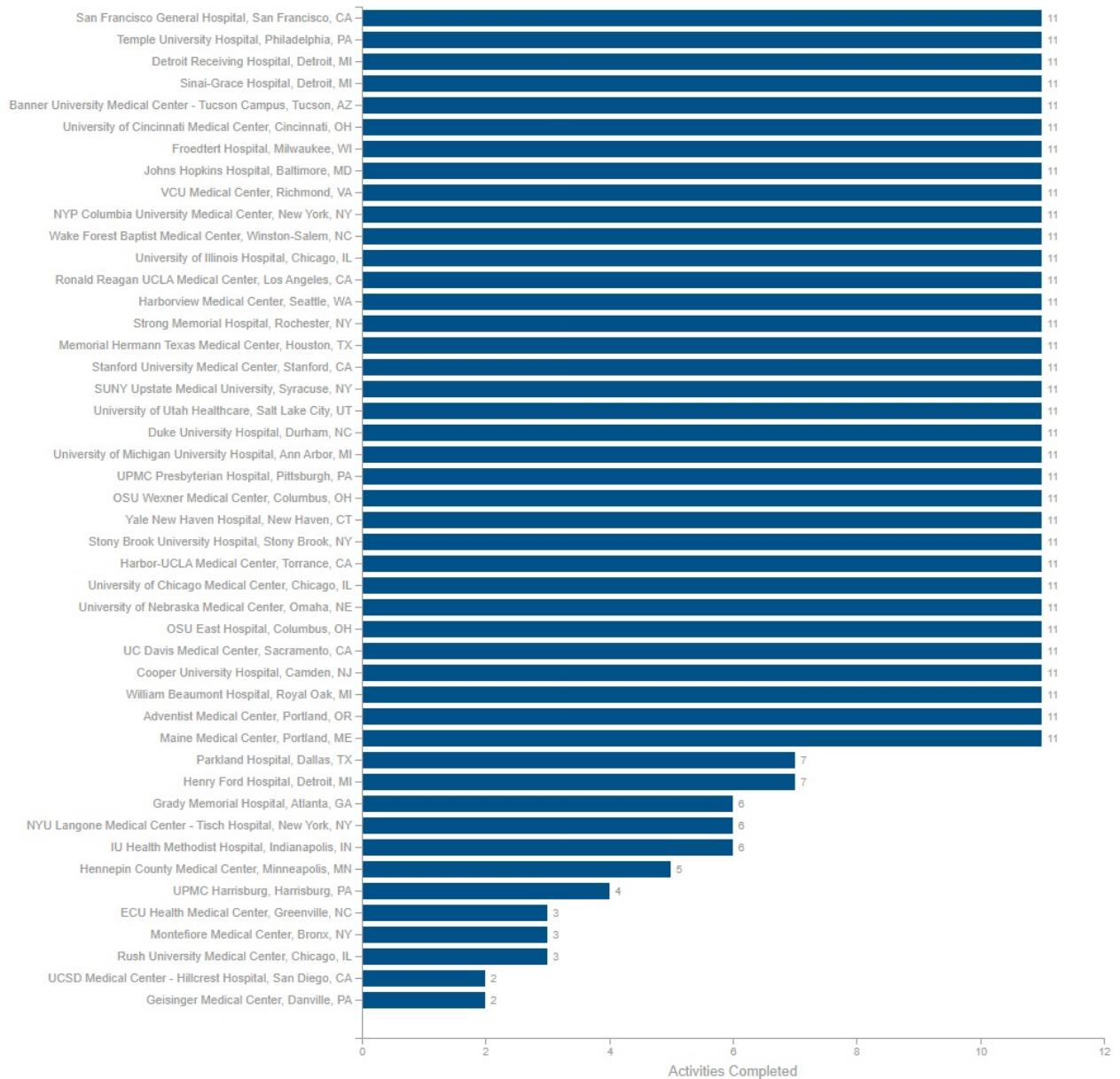

**Q:If the interview needs to be divided into two separate interviews, which measures should be prioritized?**

A:The Modified Rankin Scale (F144) is a ‘must have’ measure for all participants and should be collected first. If the subject has a MRS less than 5, in order of priority collect:

1. follow-up form (F516)
2. neuropsychological outcomes applicable to the visit type (F509, F512, F513)
3. psychological patient-reported outcomes (F507, F508, F510)
4. physical and social patient-reported outcomes applicable to the visit type (F511, F514, F515, F517, F518, F519)

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## Visit Windows

- 1 Month visit and assessments to be conducted 30 days after the date of cardiac arrest  $\pm$  15 days (day 15 to 45).
- 3 Month visit and assessments (in-person) is to be conducted 90 days after the date of cardiac arrest  $\pm$  15 days (day 75 to 105).
- 6 Month visit and assessments is to be conducted 180 days after the date of cardiac arrest  $\pm$  15 days (day 165 to 195).
- 9 Month visit and assessments is to be conducted 270 days after the date of cardiac arrest  $\pm$  15 days (day 255 to 285).
- 12 Month visit and assessment (in-person) is to be conducted 365 days after the date of cardiac arrest  $\pm$  15 days (day 350 to 380).

## WebDCU

### 9 Digit Zip Code

We have recently made an update to the database to capture the 9 digit zip code of the subject's primary residence. For past and currently enrolled subjects, this data will need to be entered retrospectively. Capturing this data point is apart of the aims outlined in the POST-ICECAP protocol, so it is important to obtain this data. We have built a secure interface to capture this information in WebDCU. Please utilize the United States Postal Service website, <https://tools.usps.com/zip-code-lookup.htm>, using the subject's current primary address to identify the full 9-digit zip code. If you have questions or concerns about this do not hesitate to reach out.

#### Accessing the Intake Form Additional for All Subject's at your Site

Under the 'Data Management' tab, there is a new table called "Intake Form Additional". If you click this table, it will show all records for each subject at your site. You can click into the individual forms by clicking the blue number hyperlink in the first column on the left side.

#### Accessing the Intake Form Additional from the F503 CRF

On the F503 Intake Questionnaire, there hyperlink in Q15 that will direct you to the Subject's secure additional form.

Once in the form, you will need to click the [Edit Record] button in the top right corner. Only Qa and Q02 (highlighted below) will need to be entered by the site, the rest of the information should be derived by WebDCU. Once the Intake Form Additional has been saved, a green arrow hyperlink should appear in A04 and take you back to the F503 CRF page.

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### IMPORTANT: WebDCU Data Entry Tip

**Please make sure you only have 1 tab of WebDCU open when entering data** We recommend sites write down or type out the necessary data needed from the ICECAP database in a separate document. Specifically the associated ICECAP ID/SF ID. We've had a few sites who had two tabs of separate databases open (1 of POST-ICECAP and 1 of

ICECAP) and it caused a glitch in the system resulting in an accidental ID entered in the wrong database. Please pass this along to your team members & let me know if you have any questions.
